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Submit two paper copies of the final paper version (including copies of tables and illustrations) to one of the two editors-in-chief:

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10. Is the manuscript written without using numbered headings?
11. Are the references listed in the order in which they appear in the text?

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The language of the journal is English. All submissions (including book reviews) must have a title and the paper submission must be printed on **one side** of the paper. The manuscripts should be written in **12pt font**, the whole document must be **double-line spaced in one column format** and have a **margin of 3cm all round**. Illustrations and tables **must** be printed on separate sheets, and **not be incorporated into the text**.

- The **title page** must list the full title, short title of up to 60 characters and names and affiliations of all authors. Give the full address, including email, telephone and fax, of the author who is to check the proofs.
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References should be cited by superior numbers and listed at the end of the paper in the **order in which they appear in the text**. All references must be complete and

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Supply each illustration on a separate sheet. There will be a limited number of **colour** illustrations in each issue of the journal: authors are requested to use black and white illustrations wherever possible. For the initial manuscript submission, you can use JPEG images in the paper. For the final submission, authors should also supply colour illustrations separately in either TIFF or EPS format, or as first generation 35 mm colour transparencies (or larger formats if available). Colour prints are also acceptable.

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
